Tasting Notes

The 2017 Cabernet Sauvignon includes 3% Petit Verdot and was aged for 20 months in 75% new French oak barrels. This rich, powerful wine is very deep purple in color and offers an abundance of black fruit and chocolate aromas with hints of graphite and an earthy minerality. It is medium to full-bodied and beautifully structured with big, solid, ripe tannins and a lingering finish. This wine will age most gracefully providing many years of enjoyment. Cheers!
