

The 2019 Napa Valley vintage is among the best of recent memory. The growing season began auspiciously with generous rainfall and mild temperatures, and continued with warm and uneventful summer weather that allowed clusters ample time to ripen. Abundant hang time and a lack of extreme heat events preserved the fruit's freshness and finesse, while coaxing out great color, rich fruit and fully mature tannins. The 2019 wines offer a wonderfully bright acidity, expressive aromatics, and complex texture.

2019 PURLIEU CABERNET SAUVIGNON

SUGARLOAF MOUNTAIN VINEYARD

Ripe and aromatic, the 2019 Purlieu Sugarloaf Mountain Cabernet Sauvignon shows off the unique complexity of southern Napa Valley terroir. The nose is rich with dark red fruit aromas, stony minerality and the gentle warmth of dried oregano. In the mouth, bright cherry and ripe blue fruits weave a nuanced tapestry with notes of graphite, mocha, and toasted fennel seed. Fine, elegant tannins and a slippery mouthfeel carry the wine into a long, sweet finish of caramelized cherries and baking spice.

"Another tour de force is the 2019 Cabernet Sauvignon Sugarloaf Vineyard, a full-bodied, powerful, structured 2019. Giving up lots of darker cassis and currant fruits as well as damp herbs and violets, it has plenty of mountain-like structure, purity, and focus on the palate. It's certainly approachable today yet deserves 2-4 years in the cellar. It should have 20 years or more of prime drinking."
